RESOLUTION NO. 28, SERIES OF 2015

A RESOLUTION FOR THE ACCEPTANCE AND DEDICATION OF ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY SOUTH OF AND ADJACENT TO EAST EVERGREEN DRIVE AND TO RANDOLPH DRIVE EXTENDED TO EAST EVERGREEN DRIVE AS PUBLIC STREETS

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Little Chute, in accordance with Sections 61.34, 61.36, and 80.01 Wis. Stats. may adopt a resolution for the purpose of the acceptance and dedication of a public street; and

WHEREAS, the Village acknowledges that a street can be acquired by the Village and dedicated pursuant to a certified survey map or other instruments; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds it to be in the public interest to dedicate Village owned lands for East Evergreen Drive and Randolph Drive.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Little Chute dedicates, as public streets, that property shown in **Exhibit A** attached hereto and designated as "Land Dedicated as Road" in the Village of Little Chute, Outagamie County, State of Wisconsin:

Described as a parcel of land being part of Lot 1 of CSM 1838, located within the NW ¼ NW ¼ of Section 15, T21N-R18E, Village of Little Chute, Outagamie County, Wisconsin being further described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner said Lot 1; thence S 0°47'34" E along the East line of said Lot for 240.80 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot; thence S 89°08'56" W along the South line of said Lot for 67.27 feet; thence N 0°52'52" W for 183.18 feet; thence N 57°16'57" W for 71.95 feet; thence S 76°46'22" W for 110.5 feet; thence S 54°19'00" W for 119.53 feet; thence N 6°11'15" W for 110.52 feet to the North line of said Lot; thence N 89°11'25" E along said North line for 343.89 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said parcel containing approximately 0.68 acre of land. Said parcel subject to all easements, covenants burdens and restrictions of record.
